What follows is the job description for the position of Family Connections Team Leader (FCTL).

It answers the Who, What, When, Where, and How of the position...

Who:

Family Connections Team Leader in close coordination with the Family Connections Pastor (FCP), staff and other TCAB team leaders.

What:

This position answers the question, "How do we make, equip and send disciples who make disciples of Jesus Christ?"

This position provides direct development, oversight and administration (planning, promoting, training, resourcing, encouraging) to the Family Connections Ministry Strategy (See attached Family Connections Strategy) including appointment of Team Members (approx 8-10).

When:

This position will serve a 3 year term from initial appointment. Weekly time invested will be approximately 1-2 hours, not including team meetings, training, etc, scheduled at the discretion of the FCTL and FCP.

Where:

The FCTL is a remote position and does not require on-site office hours at TCAB except as necessary at the discretion of the FCTL. Small groups are encouraged to take place outside of the TCAB main campus... in homes, restaurants, etc.

How/Direct Report:

The FCTL reports to the FCP and will coordinate with him to communicate clearly and consistently with the staff, elders, team leaders/members and congregation as needed. *Communication for all promotional purposes with the office team and/or the Web/App Administrator will be a priority.*

Type:

The FCTL is an unpaid/volunteer position with The Church at Bradenton.

The Leadership of TCAB is committed to providing the support, guidance, resourcing and encouragement necessary for the FCTL to lead with Christ-centered excellence.
